Package includes twin share accommodation at the above hotels, Japanese banquet dinner, and western or Japanese breakfast, (7 nights), Ferry ticket from Matsuyama Ferry Terminal to Hiroshima Prince Hotel by normal ferry (very smooth ride), Ferry ticket from Hiroshima Prince Hotel to Miyajima, One day private bus tour of Hiroshima with English speaking guide. Due to seasonal variations, the time of the cherry blossoming cannot be guaranteed.

PRICE: \$2800pp. This price does not include airfares to Japan, airfare to Matsuyama, transfer from Matsuyama Airport to hotel (easy public bus service is available), local bus and tram fares, entry ticket to Matsuyama Castle, taxi fare from the hotel in Matsuyama to the ferry terminal (about \$70 per taxi), ferry fare from Miyajima island to the mainland on 2nd Apr, train fare from Miyajima to Tokyo etc.

As an indication, airfares- Sydney to Matsuyama, and Tokyo to Sydney are from \$1277 with Qantas and \$1050 with ANA. (Contact Dai at Japan Package for details)
